This is a second-year course for advanced students. The course is designed to provide a route for the continuing in-depth study of midwifery and women's health issues. The course focuses on specific topics that midwives may want to add to their practice and knowledge base. This course includes 8 online distance education modules and 7 workshops. This course does not meet every month in order to allow students adequate time to work on the modules and their research project in between workshops. All classes will be on Sundays with the exception of the 2-day Advanced Skills weekend. Exact dates for 2011 are TBA.

Introduction:

This course is designed for adult learners. You will be expected to have a passion for the material that will carry you through the most challenging aspects of the training. You will find that you are a community of women/sisters sharing a path with various destinations. What you get out of the course will depend on what you put into it.

Pre-requisites:

CPR Adult/Infant Certification, Neonatal Resuscitation NRP (can be taken during the course year) The cost of CPR and NRP are NOT included in your tuition.

Evidence of previous academic midwifery study program

TUITION The cost for this course is **\$2250**. A deposit of \$300. is required with your registration. The remainder may be paid in 10 monthly payments of \$195. each.

Certificate of Completion You will receive a certificate of completion if you attend all of the classes, complete all of your homework, complete your Research Project, journal reviews and become CPR/NNR certified.

DISTANCE EDUCATION OPTION: There is a distance education option for the Advanced Class which includes additional assignments that would be completed in your community which replace the in person workshops.
