The **WomanCraft Course in Midwifery Studies** is an online program consisting of 10 distance education modules. Students complete work at home and receive feedback on their work through regular check ins with the instructor.

ENROLLMENT IS ONGOING

FEE : Classes are \$1500. for one year (includes all 10 modules) **Payment plans are available.** The standard payment plan is a \$300. deposit to register for the course followed by 10 payments of \$120. due approximately one month apart with the submission of each study module. In addition you will be required to purchase textbooks and a beginning equipment package for class. (We also accept Paypal payments) Course deposits are non-refundable once your enrollment has been confirmed.
